Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 3:31pm by J.Kudcey, Board Chairman.

Meeting Minutes:

Meeting Minutes #5 (September 2023) were reviewed, motion to approve by LDalpe with minor correction, seconded by JKudcey, so approved.

Old Business:

- 1. JKudcey reminded the Board to complete the Ethics course online and submit completion certificate to her for record; additionally, any of the Emery Estate event volunteers must complete a CORI with Weymouth HR (at Whipple Center).
- 2. Reminder that the Historical Society will host a Special Exhibition on Veterans Day, Nov 11, 2023 from 10:30-12:30 at Emery Estate, following the parade. The event will also include a flag retirement ceremony.
- 3. Paranormal Events: dates have been confirmed for Halloween season tours with EEAB members assisting
 - Events are scheduled for October 20, 21, 27, 28 from 6:00pm-11:00pm; with 15 tickets/tour, multiple tours/night at \$25/ticket (120 tickets sold out quickly on EventBrite); RMitchell, JWeissDonovan, JKudcey will offer a report on the event(s) at the next meeting
 - The ~\$3,000 revenue from the Halloween events (and other seasonal events) will be reinvested into the house upkeep and improvements
 - Investigatory equipment purchased by EEAB (\$914) is to remain at the Estate for guest use
- 4. Christmas Events: EEAB is planning a "Ghost of Christmas Past" Emery Open House, tentatively Dec 9 (pending participants availability)
 - EEAB member will be coordinating decoration of Emery for the holidays 12/2
 - Details are 'to be determined', but it is anticipated that there will be a reading of a classic Christmas story at this event and should appeal to all ages in our

- community as the intent of events is to bring awareness to the Town, of the Emery Estate and all it has to offer
- SReilly will reach out to Donnie Norton for story telling and assist with outdoor lighting; logistics to be discussed at next meeting
- 5. Other events currently in discussion include:
 - "Scare Your Sweetheart" in February details in process
 - Spring Tea TBD; planning a Saturday in the spring, around Mother's Day.
 - Quilting Bee/Quilt Show in summer JWeissDonovan pursuing
 - Book Club TBD

 - Civil War Re-Enactment in conjunction with Weymouth Historical Society
