It was also noted that Chapman Debit Exclusion amount \$4,460,180 will add \$.41 to Residential tax rate \$.45 to CIP tax rate.

RB made a motion to recommend a shift of 1.48% for Fiscal Year 2022, PH 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in Favor 4-0.

A Motion was made by Vice Chairman Spellman and Seconded by Mr. Brinkmann to go into Executive Session for the purpose of a discussion on ATB Cases Executive Session. All in Favor 4-0
