FEASIBILTY STUDY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OR RECONSTRUCTION OF THE CHAPMAN MIDDLE SCHOOL

Upon request of his Honor, Mayor Hedlund, The Town of Weymouth, through the Weymouth Town Council approved to appropriate the sum of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for the purpose of paying costs of a Feasibility Study for the renovation of the existing school, a renovation of and addition to the existing school and/or new construction at the Maria Weston Chapman Middle School at 1051 Commercial Street Weymouth, MA 02189, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto, and for which the Town may be eligible for a grant from the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA), said amount to be expended under the direction of the School Building Committee.

To meet this appropriation the Weymouth Town Council approves the expenditure of said amount from Fund 5218 (Chapman Feasibility Study Fund). The Town of Weymouth acknowledges that the MSBA's grant program is a non-entitlement, discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any costs the Town of Weymouth incurs in excess of any grant approved by and received from the MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the Town, and that the amount authorized pursuant to this vote shall be reduced by any grant amount set forth in the Feasibility Study Agreement that may be executed between the Town of Weymouth and the MSBA.
