MSBA STATEMENT OF INTEREST – WESSAGUSSET BOILERS

"Resolved: Having convened in an open meeting on January 17, 2017, prior to the closing date, the Town Council of Weymouth, in accordance with its charter, by-laws, and ordinances, has voted to authorize the Superintendent to submit to the Massachusetts School Building Authority the Statement of Interest that will be submitted to the MSBA by no later than Friday, February 12, 2017 for the Wessagusset Primary School located at 75 Pilgrim Rd., N. Weymouth, Massachusetts 02191 which describes and explains the following deficiencies and the priority category(s) for which an application may be submitted to the Massachusetts School Building Authority in the future

The district is seeking funding to replace the boilers which are forty-seven years old; Replacement would improve efficiency, reduce utility costs, insure non-interrupted service and extend the useful life of the building. The project is identified as a Priority Five, categorized by the School Building Authority as any replacement, renovation, or modernization of school facility systems, such as roofs, windows, boilers, heating, and ventilation systems, to increase energy conservation and decrease energy related costs in a school facility. It is and hereby further specifically acknowledges that by submitting this Statement of Interest Form, the Massachusetts School Building Authority in no way guarantees the acceptance or the approval of an application, the awarding of a grant or any other funding commitment from the Massachusetts School Building Authority, or commits the Town of Weymouth to filing an application for funding with the Massachusetts School Building Authority."
