## **REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL**

The Town of Weymouth, through its Department of Planning and Community Development, seeks proposals from interested, professionally qualified firms for engineering services required to review previous traffic control proposals, conduct a traffic study, and recommend an optimal traffic control solution for Columbian Square.

Columbian Square, the historic village center of South Weymouth, is the intersection of Pleasant Street with Columbian and Union Streets, a very wide four-legged intersection with a stop-sign control on Columbian and Union Streets. There is considerable parallel and angled on-street parking on the approach streets that are actively used for the small retail and service businesses lining the Square. The intersection operates poorly during both the morning and evening peak periods, is difficult for pedestrians to navigate, and has a high crash rate.

The product of this review/ study will be a report recommending traffic improvements considering:

- Vehicular and pedestrian safety
- Traffic flow
- Improved walkability
- On-street parking to serve abutting businesses
- Accommodation of emergency response vehicles
