Biographical / historical note: In 1911 Emily A. Porter Fifield and her daughter Mary Fifield King made a donation to Tufts Library of "some of the Fifield relics....books, papers, pictures, etc." From then until the late 1930s King continued to donate materials to the so-called Fifield Collection. Many of the materials had been owned or created by earlier generations of the family; others King may have purchased or solicited from individuals.

Some materials are stamped "Fifield Collection. 1st Parish, Dorchester". Neither the Church nor the Library has documentation to indicate when and under what circumstances the materials were transferred and King's involvement in that transfer.

As the Fifield Collection at Tuft became known, some donors to the Library described their gifts as for the Fifield Collection. There also are a few books that were donated as recently as the 1970s and evidently placed in the cabinets.

The oak and glass cabinets in the Library's Study Room are known as the Fifield Cabinets and were given to the Library by Mary Fifield King in 1914 "for the exhibiting and safekeeping of the Fifield Collection."

Scope and Contents: The cabinets in the Study Room contain a large of number or old, and possibly some rare, books. Many were owned by members of the Fifield family or collected and donated by Mary Fifield King. Others are gifts from other individuals, perhaps sometimes referring to the Library's Fifield Collection. An inventory of the books found in the cabinets follows this description. The books were not sorted and arranged. The Notes section of the inventory list may help someone determine what books might be put together by subject, genre, owner, or donor. The inscriptions are noted in the Notes section.

Several books, often in a language other than English, were given by Mrs. Maria T. Willey. Henry Willey and Maria T. Cowing, daughter of Balch and Cynthia Bates Cowing, were married in 1864 in Weymouth. Willey was a lawyer, botanist, and editor. The couple had a son, Theodore Parker Willey.
