WEYMOUTH ASSESSORS MEETING NOVEMBER 9, 2012

CHAIRMAN PAUL HALEY CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 8:30 A.M. IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM AT THE MCCULLOCH BUILDING. THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS WERE PRESENT: PAUL HALEY, CHAIRMAN; ROBERT BRINKMANN, CLERK; AND JACK SHEEHAN, ALTERNATE MEMBER.

SHE INFORMED THE BOARD THAT THE FINAL NEW GROWTH FIGURE IS \$707,000.

MRS. PANTERMOLLER PRESENTED THE BOARD WITH VARIOUS OPTIONS TO REVIEW IN ORDER TO MAKE A SHIFT RECOMMENDATION TO THE MAYOR. AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION, A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. SHEEHAN, SECONDED BY MR. BRINKMANN, AND SO VOTED UNANIMOUSLY "TO RECOMMEND A 48% SHIFT AND THAT NO RESIDENTIAL EXEMPTION BE IMPLEMENTED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013."

MRS. PANTERMOLLER ALSO INFORMED THE BOARD THAT ATTORNEY WITKIN HAS DECIDED TO TAKE HIS OFFER OFF THE TABLE FOR 51 PERFORMANCE DRIVE AND WILL GET BACK TO US.
