**RULES & REGULATIONS: ONE-DAY LIQUOR PERMIT**

1. Applicants must be familiar with the Liquor Laws of Massachusetts as noted within the application. A complete application would be submitted to the Licensing Office, along with the permit fee, payable to the Town of Weymouth. Application must be filed at least thirty (30) days prior to the event.
2. Upon receipt of the application and required fee, the applicant will be assigned a date and time on a future agenda of the Board of Licensing Commissioners. The applicant is not required to attend the meeting; questions would be addressed prior.
3. Subsequent to the Licensing Board approval, the permit would be issued by the Licensing Office.

FEE: \$30.00 All Alcohol per day (Non-Profit Organizations are only eligible)  
\$22.50 Wine & Malt per day

### PLEASE NOTE:

The Licensing Board may issue special licenses for the sale of wine and/or malt beverages to a responsible manager of any indoor or outdoor activity or enterprise (for profit or non-profit). Special licenses for the sale of *all alcoholic* beverages may be issued to non-profit organizations only as a One-Day Liquor Permit. No more than a *total of thirty* (30) days per calendar year may be issued per person/organization. Special licenses are not applicable to existing Section 12 Liquor License Holders.

Regulations for Section 14 are found in 204 CMR 7.04.

Persons holding a One-Day Liquor Permit (Section 14) must purchase alcoholic beverages from a licensed wholesaler/importer, manufacturer, farmer-winery, farmer brewery or special permit holder. A person holding a Section 14 license cannot purchase alcoholic beverages from a package store. Donations of alcoholic beverages are not permitted.
