

Minutes of the Board of Licensing Commissioners for their meeting held on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, at the Weymouth Town Hall, Chambers located at 75 Middle Street, Weymouth, MA

## **APPROVALS**

- Minutes: May 24, 2022

Mr. Richards made a MOTION to approve the minutes of May 24, 2022. Chief Stark seconded the motion and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

- One-Day Vendor Licenses: “4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration”

Ms. Knapp, Mayor’s Assistant, presented the applications for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration, stating the event would be held at the George Lane Beach Parking Lot on Sunday, July 3<sup>rd</sup> from 5 PM to 9:30 PM. She had provided a list of vendors for approval.

Mr. Richards made a MOTION to approve the One-Day Vendor Licenses as submitted. Chief Stark seconded the motion and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

- One-Day Sunday Entertainment License: Town of Weymouth (July 3<sup>rd</sup>)

Mr. Richards made a MOTION to approve the One-Day Sunday Entertainment License for the Town of Weymouth for live music and DJ. Chief Stark seconded the motion and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

Mr. Richards made a MOTION to approve a One-Day Wine & Malt Permit to Joseph Dolan for the Sports Complex rugby tournament on June 18, 2022 from 12 PM – 5 PM. Chief Stark seconded the motion and it was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

- RFP for Availability of Wine & Malt Package Store License (1)

Solicitor McLeod informed the Board that the draft was made available to include certain language for the proposed location not to be within 100 feet of schools or parks. The rating would include the location within a quarter mile of an overlay district as being highly advantageous.

There was also mention of adding the requirement of a Certificate of Good Standing submittal and the experience in the business for a period of five years, rather than one.

Mr. Richards amended the MOTION to continue the matter until the next agenda. Chief Stark seconded and the motion was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.
