Letter of Intent – Proposed Sun Room Addition 41 Jessica Lane, South Weymouth, Massachusetts

We, the undersigned, wish to extend our existing deck to create a 12.5-ft x 20-ft platform on which a 12.5-ft x 20-ft Sun Room will be installed at our home, 41 Jessica Lane, South Weymouth. The width of the proposed structure will encroach on the Rear Yard Setback requirements. We, therefore, request relief from Weymouth Zoning Ordinance Article XV, Section 120-51, "Dimensional Requirements". The Sun Room will be aesthetically consistent with existing structure and appropriate for neighborhood.

The proposed structure can only be sited in the proposed location, along the north wall of the existing structure. Siting along the west wall is impractical due to an existing 500-ft artesian well, as well existing HVAC equipment. Siting along the east or south walls is architecturally impractical based on the intended use of the Sun Room.

The undersigned believe that the proposed structure will not be detrimental to the public good as the proposed structure will not extend any further into the rear yard setback than the current deck.

Please also note that prior, similar variance requests for a larger structure were twice approved by the Board of Zoning Appeals with no comments or opposition from the public. [Reference BZA Cases #2697 and #3244.]
