After a public hearing on April 15, 2015, the Board of Zoning Appeals at its meeting of April 15, 2015:

VOTED TO GRANT THE SPECIAL PERMIT under Weymouth Zoning Ordinance Article XXI, Section 120-2B(1), Wireless communications free-standing structure, to allow for installation of AT&T's antennas on an existing 150 ft. lattice tower, and to add an equipment shelter and associated diesel generator northwest of the tower, shown on plan by Chappell Engineering Associates, LLC, revised March 2, 2015.

Under MGL Chapter 40A, Section 11, the approval of the Board of Zoning Appeals will NOT take effect until it has been recorded in the Norfolk Registry of Deeds.

When a receipt from the Registry of Deeds is presented to the Building Inspector (to show that the decision has been recorded), the proper permit will be issued.
