Thank you for your interest in the 2020 Weymouth Farmers Market at the Weymouth High School. For those of you who are returning vendors- welcome back and thank you for your continued support! For those applying for the first time- welcome, we look forward to working with you. This year's market will run similarly to last year's, and is set for Sundays from 10AM – 1PM, from June 21st through October 4th. The last market, October 4th, will coincide with the Town's annual Great Pumpkin Give-a-Wey event and will occur from 12pm-4pm on that day. More info regarding this event will be provided as we approach it.

Applying to the Market

All interested vendors (both returning and new) must fill out the following application and forms and submit them to the Market Steering Committee before May 1st, 2020.

- 2020 Token Agreement
- Check Made out to the "Town of Weymouth"

Once approved, vendors then will need to apply for a food permit through the Health Department, if required based on the product sold.
