

NARRATIVE

Request to Amend Order of Conditions Under the Local Wetlands
Protection Ordinance Only
(Section 7-301 of the Weymouth Code of Ordinances).

720 Pleasant Street Weymouth, Massachusetts

The Conservation Commission issued an Order of Conditions on August 13, 2019 (MassDEP File Number 81-1248) for the construction of a single-family building, access driveway, supporting utilities and drainage improvements. The issued Order of Conditions was then appealed by an abutter. DEP then issued a Superseding Order of Conditions on January 28, 2020. This request to Amend the Order of Conditions is being submitted under the Local Wetlands Protection Ordinance only, to ensure that the plan approved and referenced in the Superseding Order of Conditions issued by the DEP is the same plan on-file at the Weymouth Conservation Commission.

Revisions to the plan included reducing the size of the proposed dwelling, eliminating the garage, repositioning the dwelling further away from the resource area, and reducing the driveway length. The portion of the property that was formerly proposed for the dwelling is now proposed to be lawn area and the rear slope shall be reshaped and revegetated.
