



FIRST FLOOR PLAN



This detailed floor plan illustrates the second floor of a library, featuring a variety of study and program spaces. The plan is color-coded to distinguish between different functional areas: blue for adult study and reading, green for teen study and reading, brown for teen programs and storage, yellow for collection storage, purple for local history, and grey for administrative offices and restrooms.

Key Rooms and Features:

- Adult Study and Reading:** Includes Adult Nonfiction Reading (224), Adult Fiction Reading (223), Quiet Study (218), and several Group Study rooms (216, 217, 219, 220, 221, 222).
- Reference and Work:** Features a large Reference Room (225), a Reference Work Room (207), and a Collection Storage room (205).
- Teen Study and Reading:** Includes Teen Study (227A, 227B), Teen Reading (227), Teen Reference (227A), and Teen Storage (228A).
- Teen Programs:** A dedicated Teen Program room (228) is located near the teen storage area.
- Local History:** Two rooms are dedicated to local history: Local History Archive (202A) and Local History (202).
- Offices and Support Spaces:** Includes the Assistant Directors Office (214), Directors Office (213), Admins Office (212), Staff Office (208), Staff Break/Lockers/Secure Storage (211), and various restrooms (Men's 204, Women's 206, Staff 215).
- Conference and Meeting:** Features a Digital Media/Meeting Room (203), a Conference Room (231), and another Conference Room (232).
- Storage and Circulation:** Includes Periodicals (201), New Books (234), and an IT Closet (229).
- Staircases and Elevators:** The floor includes Stair 1 (S1), Stair 2 (S2), Stair 3 (S3), and an Elevator (E1).

The plan also shows the layout of furniture, including tables, chairs, and bookshelves, providing a comprehensive view of the second floor's operational space.
