Since our last weekly report, the following has occurred:

1. Light Blocking Technology Billboards:

The Town has selected a vendor. In addition, as reported last week, the Town has made certain requests as to the operation of the board relating to the intensity of the lights. What must be considered is that the purpose of installing light blocking technology is to block the lights from the neighborhood. Where there may be some visible light, it is expected to be much less intensive due to the particular billboard product.

Cove will be finalizing any Town concerns and will be ordering the new signs next week.

2. Tree Cutting Permits:

The Conservation Commission has approved the Order of Conditions. We will be forwarding this to the state along with other documents necessary for the tree cutting application.

As stated in previous updates, the DOT is seeking input from town residents on this tree cutting application. Again, for your review, I am attaching the power point presentation which depicts which trees will be removed.

If you have interest in providing your input, please email me and we will include your communication in the DOT application. We want to file this with DOT next week.
