For Immediate Release – April 11, 2020

Any bills issued with a due date of March 10, 2020, or later are now due on June 1, 2020, regardless of the due date printed on the bill.

Exemption and Deferral Applications:

Mayor Hedlund is also extending the due date of Property Tax Personal Exemption and Tax Deferral Applications:

Original Due Date: April 1, 2020

Extended Due Date: June 1, 2020

In addition, Mayor Hedlund is waiving all interest and other penalties until July 1, 2020 in the event of a late payment of any real estate, personal property, motor vehicle excise, water/sewer utility bill with a due date of March 10, 2020 or later. Weymouth taxpayers now have until June 30, 2020 to make the payment without incurring interest or other penalties.

Under the new state law, payments made after June 30, 2020 will be subject to interest and penalties back to the due date of June 1.

Weymouth taxpayers are encouraged to use the town's online payment option to conveniently pay real estate, personal property, excise taxes, and water/sewer bills. As previously announced, Mayor Hedlund has waived the online convenience fee (which is charged by the vendor, not the Town) for credit card payments.

Payments can also be made by mail or by using the outside payment box at Town Hall.
