RE: Notification of Extended Construction Hours Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC Weymouth Compressor Station (Transmittal No. X266786)

Dear Mr. Cushing:

Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC (Algonquin) was issued Air Quality Plan Approval - Transmittal No. X266786 (the Plan Approval) by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) on August 26, 2019. The Plan Approval authorizes the construction and operation of the Weymouth Compressor Station, 50 Bridge Street, Weymouth, Massachusetts.

In accordance with Table 12, Condition 9, Algonquin is required to provide 48 hours advance notice to the Town of Weymouth and MassDEP prior to commencement of any commissioning activity that will occur outside the hours of 7 AM to 7 PM. Commissioning activities have commenced at the Weymouth Compressor Station and are planned to occur between the hours of 7 AM to 7 PM, Monday through Saturday only. During the week of September 14th through September 19th, however, there is the potential necessity for some activities to run past 7 PM to complete testing commenced earlier in the day and to reduce pressure to proper shutdown levels prior to concluding for the night. These commissioning activities are the same activities that were the subject of the letter sent to you on September 10th.
