Dear Mr. Cushing:

Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC (Algonquin) was issued Air Quality Plan Approval - Transmittal No. X266786 (the Plan Approval) by the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) on August 26, 2019. The Plan Approval authorizes the construction and operation of the Weymouth Compressor Station, 50 Bridge Street, Weymouth, Massachusetts.

In accordance with Table 12, Condition 9, Algonquin is required to provide 48 hours advance notice to the Town of Weymouth and MassDEP prior to commencement of any commissioning activity that will occur outside the hours of 7 AM to 7 PM. On Monday and Tuesday of next week, September 21<sup>st</sup> through September 27<sup>th</sup>, there is the potential necessity for some activities to run past 7 PM to complete testing commenced earlier in the day and reduce pressure to proper shutdown levels prior to concluding commissioning activities for the night. In addition, as part of the commissioning process, the turbine is scheduled to startup on September 23<sup>rd</sup> for a 100-hour run, which involves operating the unit for approximately 100 hours with intermittent stops as needed for inspection. Therefore, starting September 23<sup>rd</sup> and extending through Sunday, September 27<sup>th</sup>, commissioning activities will occur up to 24 hours per day.
