**CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN PRESENTATION – FY21**

Mr. Langill stated they met with department heads at the end of January and there are approximately 60 priority 1's. The items in green are already funded. Libby restrooms and batting cages across from Town Hall to be done by end of summer 2020. Weston Park and Tufts Library; \$100,000 in new materials, \$50,000 grant match for Columbian Square, Electric vehicles/ 5 vehicles, road and sidewalk bonding to begin this spring.

- Item 4) Roadway resurfacing; will email the specifics on "road program".
- Items 5) Roadway drainage projects various locations
- Item 12) Elder Services, storage garage
- Item 18) Fire Department, radios, to be used by fire and police and EMT together – P25 System.
- Item 28) Parks & Recreation, Weston/Tufts Playground – all compliant.
- Item 29) Parks & Recreation, Sarah Brassil Park – new playground equipment, fencing basketball court, fencing and trail system with parking and signage, CPC request.
- Item 30) Parks & Recreation, Libby Building Upgrades, new building to house bathrooms, concessions, storage and separate batting cages.
- Item 34) Police, radios
- Item 35) Police, cruisers – 7
- Item 41) Schools, garage, transportation/WeyCare engineering study being done now to see where to move TMS garage to.
- Item 44) Schools, technology devices

- Item 48) Schools, Middle Street crosswalk lights at Abigail Adams Middle School
- Item 53) Sewer, pump station rehabilitation
- Item 54) Sewer, Annual Inflow and Infiltration
- Item 55) Town Council, Replace HVAC system in Council Chambers
- Item 56) Water, water treatment plants/facilities
- Item 58) Water, water main replacement program
- Item 59) Water, Great Pond Dam, out to bid
