

House Rock Trail

Access: Parking for House Rock Park is located off House Rock Road

Trail: .34 mile



Welcome to **House Rock Trail**, a .34 mile trail traversing the 24 acres of conservation land behind House Rock Park.

House Rock, located at the trail-head, is considered one of the largest freestanding boulders in New England. Also known as an erratic, these boulders were broken and moved around during the last glacial retreat 10,000 years ago.

As is the case with all the town's trails, all dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6ft. Please pick up after your dog and check for ticks.
