**Regulation #8
The Sale and/or Barter of Fruits, Vegetables, Meats, Fish
and all other Perishable Goods**

The Board of Health of the Town of Weymouth, Massachusetts, acting under the authority of the General Laws, Chapter III, Section 31, and Chapter III, Section 143, and in accordance therewith and in the interest of and for the preservation of public health, hereby adopts the following Regulation #8, governing the sale and/or barter of fruits, vegetables, meats, fish and all other perishable goods at all locations except those licensed by the Board of Health as retail food establishments and owner operated stands on the property where said product being sold and/or bartered is grown or raised.

No person, firm or corporation shall engage in the sale and/or barter of any fruits, vegetables, meats, fish or any other perishable goods except at a location licensed by the Board of Health as a retail food establishment or an owner operated stand on the property where said product to be sold and/or bartered is grown or raised.

Whoever violates any provisions of the foregoing regulation or order made thereunder, shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty (50) dollars and not more than five hundred (500) dollars for each day such violation continues as set forth in Chapter III, Section 146, of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

This regulation was adopted by a unanimous vote of the Board of Health at a regular meeting held June 30, 1975 to be effective July 7, 1975.
