Pursuant to sections 2-4(a), 3-1(c), and 4-4(a) of the Town Charter, I hereby submit the following measure to Town Council for its consideration and action:

SECTION 14. This measure shall take effect upon the organization of the town government following the next biennial town election, which is expected to occur on the first business day of January following the next biennial town election, or Thursday, January 2, 2020.

This measure will need legal notice and a public hearing.

Summary of Chief Executive Salary Comparisons:

When compared to 21 municipalities throughout Massachusetts (15 communities with Mayors as chief executives and 6 communities with managers/administrators), the Town of Weymouth's Chief Executive salary is substantially lower in total dollars, percent of total budget, and per capita cost on average.

Based on the comparison communities used in this analysis:

- The average chief executive's salary is \$143,777
 - For cities/mayor forms of government, this average is \$137,987
 - Manager/Administrators' average salary is \$158,252
 - The highest salary used was \$202,718 and the lowest \$105,000
- **Weymouth's Chief Executive salary is \$110,000 equal to \$33,777 or 23.5% less than the average salary**

- The Chief Executive's salary accounted for 0.09% of the total budgets on average
 - For cities/mayors this is equal to 0.07% on average
 - For managers/administrators this is equal to 0.15% on average
- **Weymouth's salary is 0.07% of the total budget, or 0.02% less than comparison communities**

- The average per capita cost for salaries is \$3.41
 - For cities/mayors this cost is, on average, \$2.45
 - For managers/administrators this is \$5.82/capita

- **On average, Weymouth's per capita cost for its Chief Executive is \$1.47 less than the comparison communities. This is 43% less than the average per capita cost.**
 - Only 4 communities had a lower per capita cost (Boston, Brockton, Malden, and Quincy). This can be attributed to the high population counts reducing per capita costs, as in the case of Boston, Brockton, and Quincy, or the uncharacteristically low salary for the chief executive, in the case of Malden.

- When adjusted for inflation, the Town of Weymouth's Chief Executive Salary of \$110,000 (the rate from 1999) is equal to \$165,948.69 in 2018 figures.
