20 099-Amendment to the Appropriation Amount Necessary for Replacing the Ralph Talbot Primary School Boiler System, Order 20 011

Some costs were estimated in the initial reimbursement application submitted to MSBA. Chief of Staff Langill reported the current measure includes the updated actual cost of \$1,324,754 to replace two boilers at the Talbot School.

Councilor Kiely asked if the total includes any incentives from the utilities? Mr. Langill responded that it includes no utility discounts nor the \$599,000 reimbursement from MSBA.
