Call to Order

At 7:00 p.m. Chair Belmarsh called for a motion. Approval of Minutes

Town Wide Parents Council will be doing a candidates forum with the School Committee on October 15th.

Mrs. Curran announced there is a football game is tomorrow night against Framingham here at Weymouth High School.

Superintendent's Report

Dr. Salim shared information regarding the MCAS and PARCC timelines. Dr. Salim outlined when results would be shared.

Dr. Salim reminded everyone about the Family and Community Event will be happening on Saturday, September 29th from 10-3 at Weymouth High School.

Dr. Salim shared that we had our first dedication event at the Pingree School for the buddy bench that was donated by Lisa Maroney. The bench at Pingree was dedicated to her son Colin as well as Joanna Mullin who both have passed away.

Mrs. Nardone stated she went to each school this past Sunday to look at the benches, they are perfectly placed.

On October 9th the Weymouth High School Band and Chorus will be performing at the Providence Bruins game. There are flyers in the back with more information.

Maintenance and Facilities Update

Dr. Salim invited Director of Maintenance, Paul Comerford to the table. Mr. Comerford provided the committee with a powerpoint presentation. Mr. Comerford provided an update on the initial goals of the department, hiring, beautification of the schools and safety in the workplace. He then gave an update on the work that was done to each building over the summer which included the window washing and repaving at Johnson Early Childhood Center, painting entrances at several of the schools. Repaving was also done at Hamilton and sidewalk replacement. There is 1.1 million square feet of floor space in the district. Mr. Comerford thanked the team for their hard work of getting the floors done.

Carpeting was removed, replaced and or cleaned in many of the schools. Gym floors were refinished.

Mr. Comerford spoke about door replacements, roof analysis at all schools and painting at each school. Spoke about the buddy benches that were installed and air conditioning that was installed at Wessagusset library.

Mr. Comerford reported that the high school track was refinished. He spoke about the lighting that was replaced at Academy, also the new classroom that was built at Academy to accommodate the kindergarten.

Finally, Mr. Comerford reviewed the AHERA plan updates.

Mr. Comerford answered questions from the Committee in detail.

Chair Belmarsh thanked Mr. Comerford for his updates.

Capital Update

Dr. Salim reviewed the FY17 Capital Plan and the updates to the capital plan in detail for the Committee. Dr. Salim describes the details and will discuss the Chapman project in Chapman Feasibility later in the meeting. Dr. Salim reviewed the damage to the air conditioner at the high school Gold Building from the previous winter. Mr. Comerford discussed. Dr. Salim reviewed the need for computer hardware replacement,

There will be several items for the Committee to vote on later in the meeting. Mrs. Curran asked about tile replacement and it is not on there? Mr. Comerford discussed.

Ms. Belmarsh asked for clarification on the master plan. Mr. Comerford clarified. Discussion continued and Mr. Comerford addressed each question.

Chair Belmarsh reminded that free cash will be certified in the coming months.

Chair Belmarsh thanked Mr. Comerford for his report.
