

WEYMOUTH ASSESSORS MEETING
NOVEMBER 12, 2014

VICE CHAIRMAN KEVIN SPELLMAN CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 6:30 P.M. IN ROOM 10 AT THE MCCULLOCH BUILDING. THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS WERE PRESENT: KEVIN SPELLMAN, VICE CHAIRMAN; ROBERT BRINKMANN, CLERK; AND JACK SHEEHAN, ALTERNATE MEMBER.

MRS. PANTERMOLLER PRESENTED THE BOARD WITH A BREAKDOWN OF POSSIBLE SHIFTS AT VARIOUS PERCENTAGES FOR THEIR REVIEW.

AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION, A MOTION WAS MADE BY MR. BRINKMAN, SECONDED BY MR. SPELLMAN, AND SO VOTED UNANIMOUSLY "TO RECOMMEND TO THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL A 55% SHIFT FOR CLASSIFICATION PURPOSES AND THAT NO RESIDENTIAL EXEMPTION BE IMPLEMENTED FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015."

MRS. PANTERMOLLER ALSO REPORTED TO THE BOARD THAT THE NEW GROWTH FOR FY 15 IS \$750,000.00.
