### Explore the neighborhood

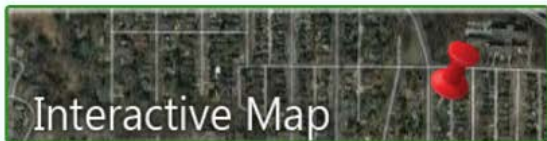
Fire insurance maps and atlases show entire communities as they were in the past, including businesses, private homes, public places, apartment buildings and government offices.

### INTERACTIVE MAP SEARCH

Use the Interactive Map search function to identify potential map coverage at a precise location.

Search by entering an address, lat/long, or name of the location of interest. Or simply click on the map to set a marker at the property of interest.

### PLACE NAME SEARCH

Use Place Name search to find map publications for a city, county, or other place in the drop down list for a selected state.

Place names include current and historical names for cities and towns, neighborhoods, unincorporated villages or other populated areas.

# INTERACTIVE MAP SEARCH

## STEP 1: GENERATE PUBLICATION LIST

Use the Interactive Map search function to identify potential map coverage at a precise location.

**1A** Enter an address or a lat/long coordinate, then click Go.

or

**1B** Navigate and zoom to the property of interest and click on the map to set a marker.

SCREEN CAPTURE

When searching with interactive maps, you can “Show” the index map as an overlay, directly on top of the Google Maps search interface.

**2B** Locate the Map Sheet number for the specific publication for your property of interest

## STEP 1: GENERATE PUBLICATION LIST

Use Place Name search to find map publications for a city, county, or other place in the selected state.

- 1A** Choose the State from the drop-down menu.
- 1B** Choose the Place Name from the second drop-down menu.

Research Tip: Place Names and Publication Titles do not always match! Select a Publication Title from the list below, then use the Research Tools or Map Sheets to see if your area of interest has map coverage.

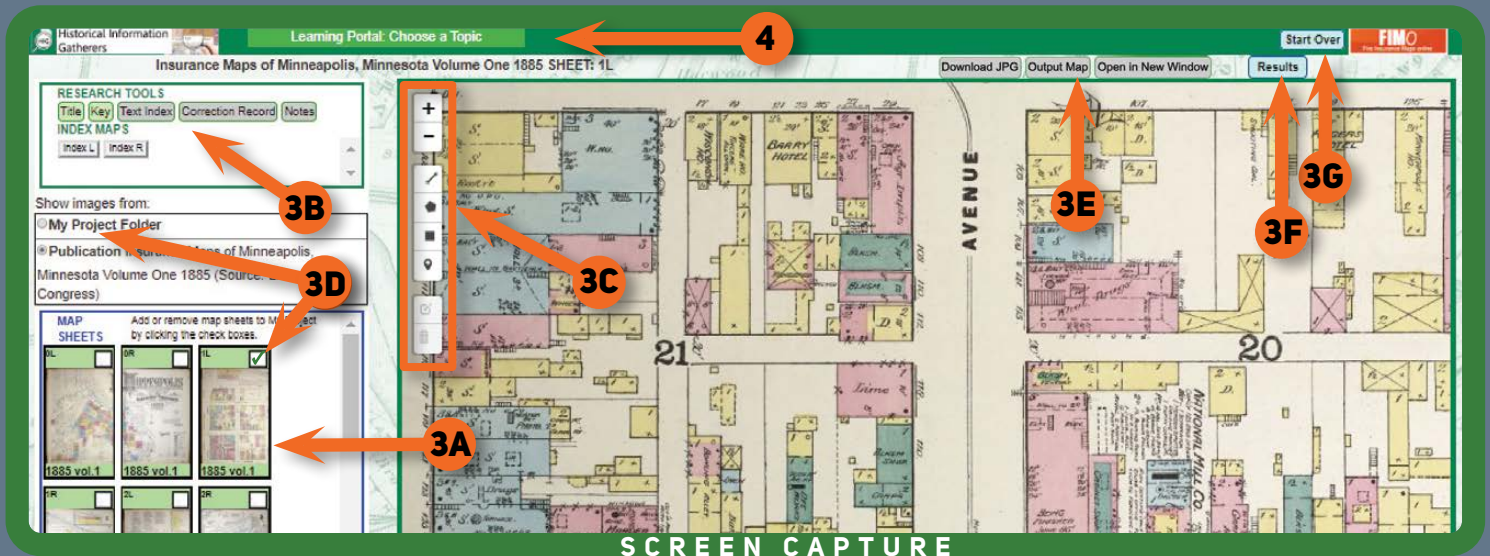

### STEP 3: READ AND WORK WITH MAPS

- 3A** Click on map sheet found in STEP 2.
- 3B** Read the Map with the aid of Research Tools
- 3C** Mark up the map using the Drawing Tools.
- 3D** Temporarily save the map by clicking on its check-box and refer back to it in “My Project Folder” for quick reference (folder will be cleared upon logout).
- 3E** Create PDF (to save or print) and download full resolution Jpegs (if available).
- 3F** Go back to Search Results to view other map publications.
- 3G** Start Over to complete a new search.
