Town Council Meeting, October 3, 2011

Budget/Management Meeting, October 11, 2011

<u>COMMUNICATION AND REPORTS FROM THE MAYOR, TOWN OFFICERS,</u> <u>AND TOWN BOARDS</u>

<u>11 122- General Government Supplemental Fiscal Year 2012 Appropriation-</u> reaffirmation

CFO McKinney requested on behalf of the Mayor; that the Town of Weymouth raise and appropriate the sum of \$130,791,319, which is \$518,246 greater than the amount of the annual appropriation of \$130,273,073, voted by Council on June 20, 2011 in Measure 11-025, to provide for all the expenses for the maintenance and operation of the town's several departments and activities for Fiscal Year 2012 by re-appropriating the following line item in the following amounts:

Line Item description - Chapter 70-increase \$518,246 and on the expense side, for the school department-increase: \$518,246 Furthermore, that the sum of \$40,000 is appropriated from the Waterways Fund to meet some of the costs of the Harbormaster's Program; a restatement of Measure 11-025.

A MOTION was made by Vice President O'Connor to refer item 11 122 to the Budget/Management Committee and was seconded by Councilor Smart.

Council President Mathews asked Solicitor Lane to confirm the reaffirmation does not require a public hearing. Solicitor Lane responded that in accordance with a memo in writing to the Council President dated October 26, 2011:

"There is no public hearing required on Measure No. 11-122 which is a legislative reaffirmation of Measure No. 11-116. A public hearing by Town Council was previously held on Measure No 11-116, as required by Town Charter, Town Ordinances and other provisions of laws, full disclosure and debate of all pertinent figures and expenditures having been discussed and deliberated."

UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

11 123-Creation of Special Purpose Stabilization Fund

CFO McKinney requested on behalf of the mayor; *that the Town of Weymouth transfer the sum of* \$86,240.84 *from Fund* 5233, *LNR Settlement, into a newly created Special*

Purpose Stabilization Fund in accord with MGL Ch.40, §b, for the purpose of funding capital projects.

A MOTION was made by Vice President O'Connor to refer item 11 123 to the Budget/Management Committee and was seconded by Councilor Smart. President Mathews thanked the mayor for presenting this measure. UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.
