Mr. Hall stated that they plan for a retail/commercial, civic use and that this combination makes for a great place.

Councilor McPherson asked if they have done market research.

Councilor Leary stated that he is concerned down the road with regards to the occupancy rates.

Councilor McPherson asked for the percentage of owner/rental occupied. He was told 80 percent owned, 20 percent rental.

Councilor Kay stated that she had done some research on the over 65 population and that this population will only continue to grow. She will recommend doubling the 300 units proposed.

Councilor DiFazio stated that they are voting for a conceptual idea and besides zoning controls how is this kept on track?

Councilor Leary asked when the Town Council will be asked to vote.

Councilor McPherson asked when a revised plan will be presented.

Councilor Kay asked how quickly the plan will be presented to the public. What is the timeline/plan?

Lennar responded that Tri- Town has two peer reviews and a final plan will be completed by the end of January. The scope of reviews will be forwarded immediately.

Councilor DiFazio stated that there will be a series of public hearings and that there is still a lot of valuable input to be heard.

Councilor McPherson stated that the public hearings will be in January once the traffic studies are known.

Councilor Smart stated that in regards to the Union Street gate, he does not want to see Union Street opened.
