Town Council Meeting-1/22/08

A MOTION was made by Councilor Mathews to ACCEPT the minutes from 1/22/08 and was seconded by Councilor O'Connor and UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

COMMUNICATION FROM MAYOR, TOWN OFFICERS, AND TOWN BOARDS

08 012-Acceptance of Land Donation-103 Norton Street

Solicitor Lane stated that the owner of 103 Norton Street, Harold B. Nash, has donated this property to the Town of Weymouth. The measure reads as follows:

• That the Town of Weymouth, through Town Council, authorize the acceptance of a bequest of land for conservation purposes, located at 103 Norton Street, Weymouth, and containing approximately 108,000 square feet, and abutting the Weymouth Fore River and conservation land.

Councilor Conlon noted that there appears to be a structure on the site along with debris. Solicitor Lane pointed out that there is another parcel adjacent to this lot.

Councilor Conlon pointed out that there is a chain link fence but the gate is open; a lock is needed. Solicitor Lane stated that this would be brought to DPW attention.

A MOTION was made by Councilor Mathews to REFER item number 08 012 to the Budget/Management Committee and was seconded by Councilor O'Connor and was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

08 013-Compact Disc Antitrust Litigation Distribution-Action Requested under 2-9b

Solicitor Lane stated that this item is a request to accept a monetary distribution in connection with the Attorney General's Compact Disc Litigation Settlement. He pointed out that this item is being requested under 2-9b action because it is time sensitive and must be completed by 3/13/08-the timetable set forth by Attorney General. There is still administrative work to be done. The measure reads as follows:

• That the Town of Weymouth, through the Weymouth Town Council authorize the acceptance of a monetary distribution in connection with the Attorney Generals' Compact Disc Litigation Settlement relating to public libraries, and to further authorize the creation of the CD Antitrust Litigation Settlement Account, and with the consent of the Mayor, authorize the Library Director to expend those funds, and any earned interest, as specified in said Settlement.

A MOTION was made by Councilor Mathews to take item number 08 013 UNDER 2-9b, same night action, and was seconded by Councilor O'Connor and was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

A MOTION was made by Councilor Mathews to APPROVE favorable action on item number 08 013 and was seconded by Councilor O'Connor and was UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

08 014-Archaelogical Study-43 Bicknell Road
