ORDER FOR JOINT LOCATIONS - EXISTING POLES

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

that **MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY** and **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** each having locations in certain of the streets of the municipality, be and they are hereby granted a joint location for and permission jointly to maintain poles already existing and their respective wires to be placed thereon, together with such sustaining and protective fixtures as any of said Companies may deem necessary, in the public way or ways hereinafter referred to, as requested in petition of said Companies dated the **23rd day of August, 2019**

All construction under this order shall be in accordance with the following conditions:--

Poles shall be of sound timber, and reasonably straight, and shall be set substantially at the points indicated upon the plan marked-- **MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY** and **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.**

Plan No. **27871401** Dated: **8/23/2019** filed with said petition

There may be attached to said poles by said **MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY** not to exceed twenty wires and by said **VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC.** not to exceed forty wires and four aerial cables and all of said wires and cables shall be placed at a height of not less than eighteen feet from the ground.

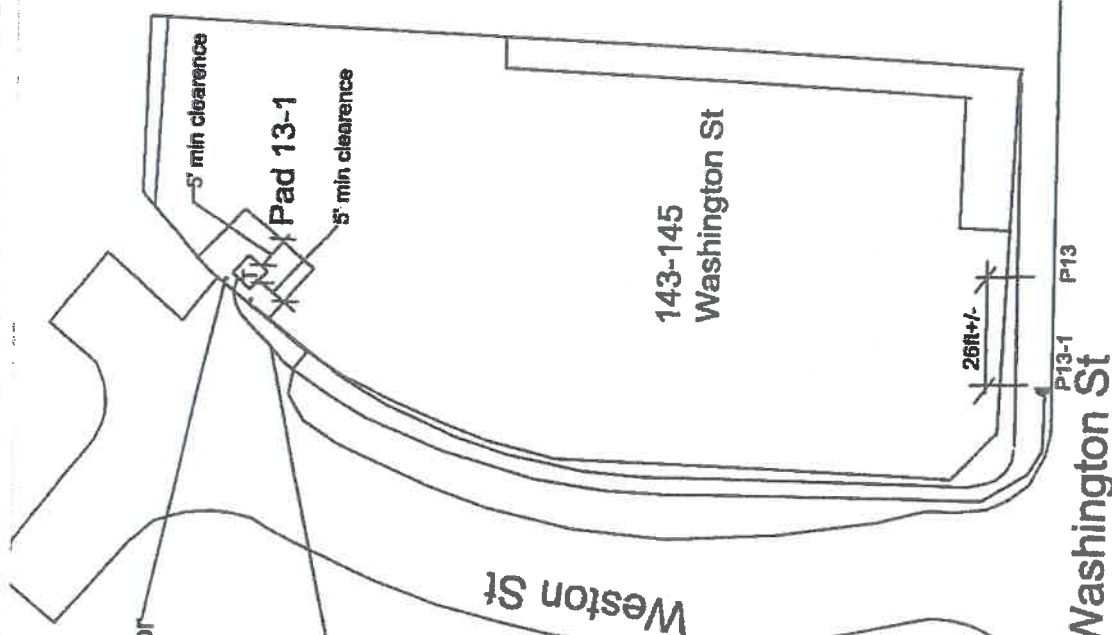

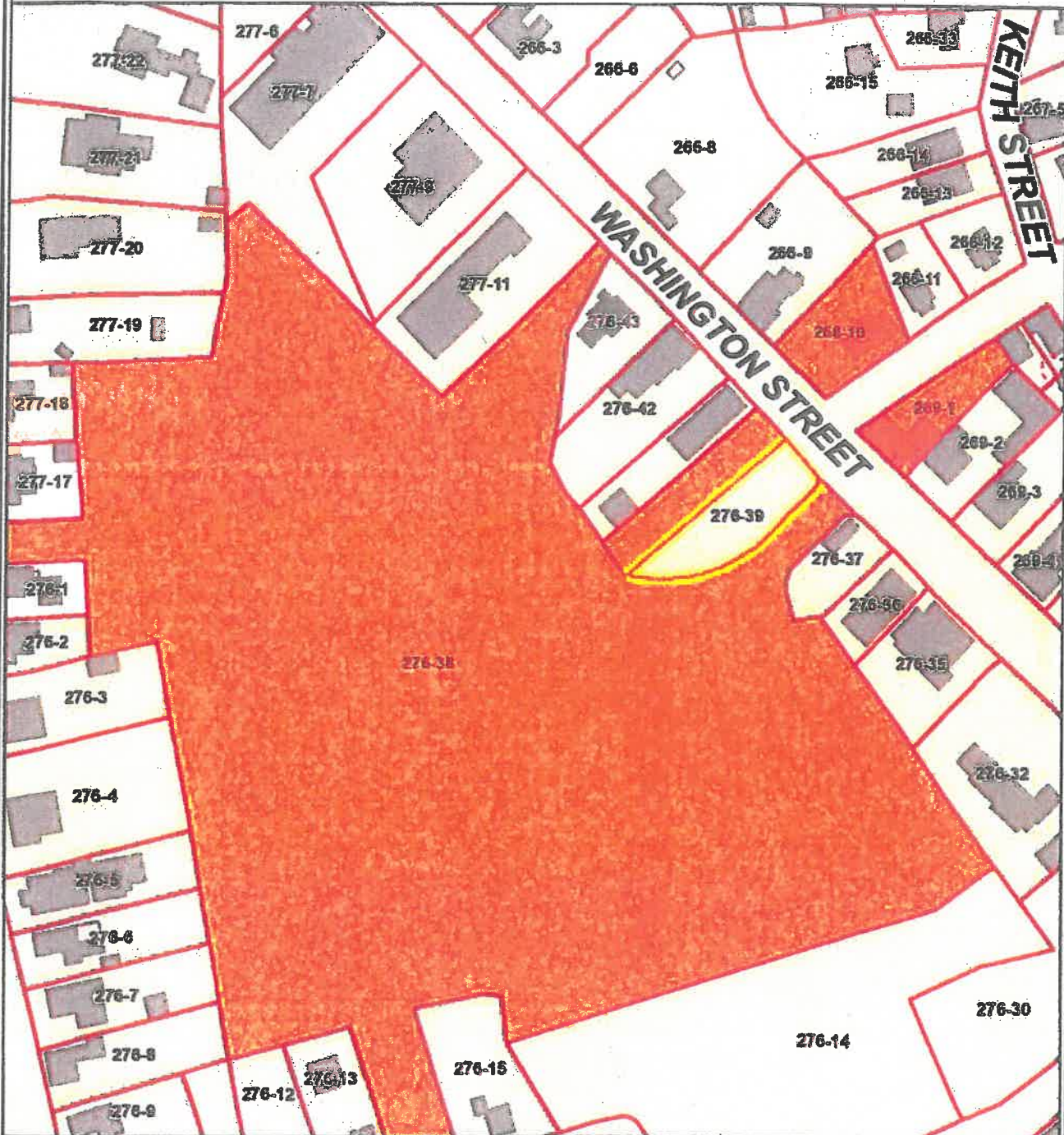
