Please adhere to the following:

1. You must register by contacting my office at 781-682-3618 by **Wednesday, April 24, 2024.**
2. Please fill out the attached release, (one per person), and return it to the Town of Weymouth, Office of the Mayor, 75 Middle Street, Weymouth, MA 02189; fax to (781)335-8184; or email to kknapp@weymouth.ma.us, on or before **Friday, April 26, 2024.** If you need more copies, please call and we will send more.
3. Gloves and trash/yard waste bags will be provided and will be available for pick up between 8:00am and 9:00am on Saturday, April 27th, 2024, at the Department of Public Works, 120 Winter Street, for all **registered participants.** Volunteers are encouraged to bring their own clean-up equipment, i.e., rakes, brooms, leaf blowers, on the day of the event.
4. Please sort as follows:
 - Yard waste must be placed in yard waste bags
 - Litter should be placed in separate trash bags
 - Metal and larger objects should be piled separately
5. The Department of Public Works will arrange for trash/yard waste to be picked up for all **registered participants,** beginning at Noon on April 27th, 2024.

Lunch will be provided for all volunteers from Noon until 1:30pm at King Oak Hill Park, Emery Lane, Weymouth, immediately following the event.
