

PETITION OF NATIONAL GRID FOR GAS MAIN LOCATIONS

Town of Weymouth / Town Council:

The Nationalgrid hereby respectfully requests your consent to the locations of mains as hereinafter described for the transmission and distribution of gas in and under the following public streets, lanes, highways and places of the **Town of Weymouth** and of the pipes, valves, governors, manholes and other structures, fixtures and appurtenances designed or intended to protect or operate said mains and accomplish the objects of said Company; and the digging up and opening the ground to lay or place same:

To install and maintain approximately 210 feet more or less of 4 inch gas main in North St., Weymouth, from existing 4 inch gas main at house #240 northerly to the intersection of Shaw St. and approximately 1275 feet more or less of 4 inch gas main in Shaw St., from the new gas main in North St. easterly to the existing 3 inch gas main in Green St. at #84. All of which to replace and abandon the existing 2 inch gas main in North St. and the existing 2 inch gas main in Shaw St.

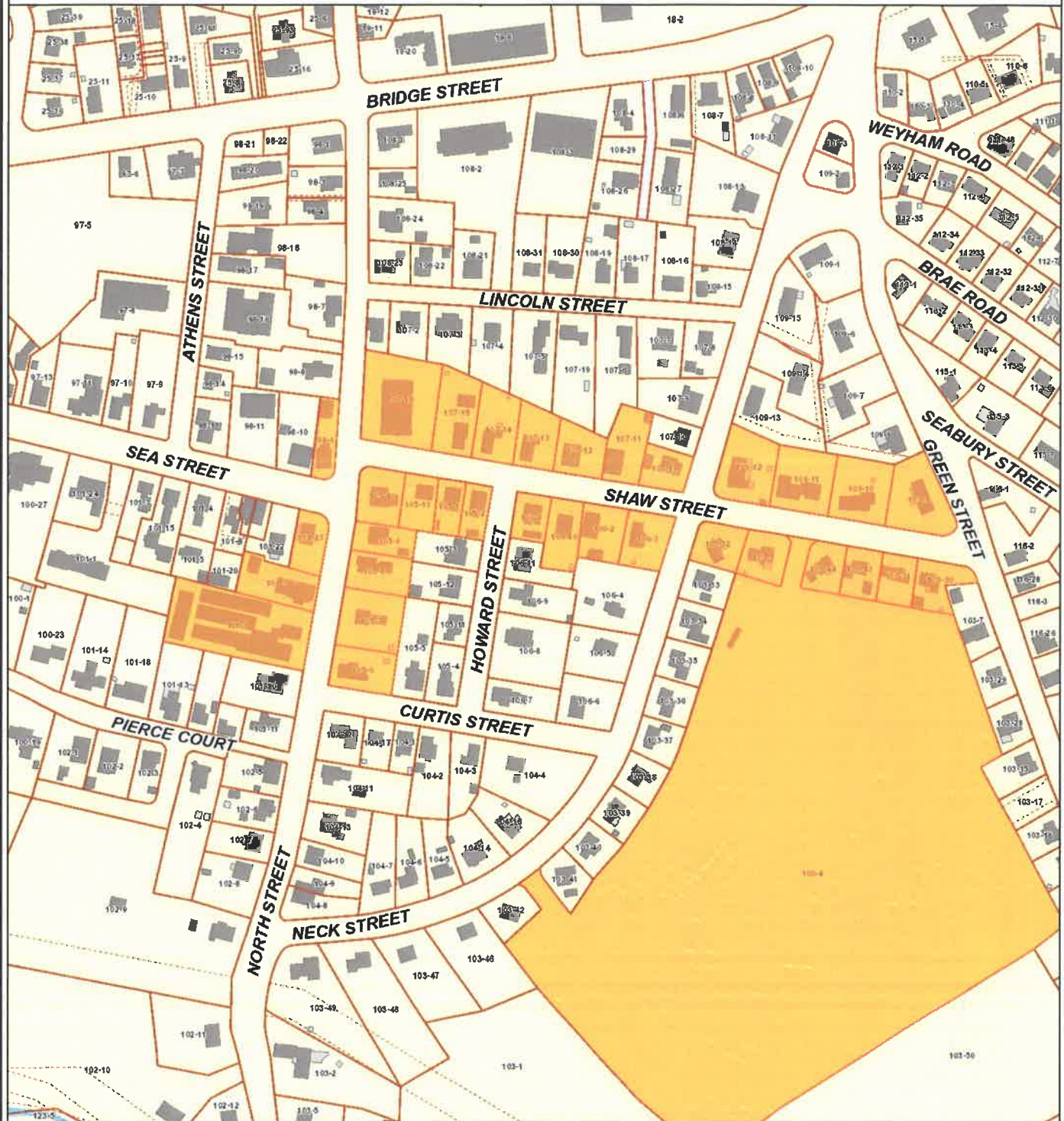
