I submit the following measure to Town Council for its consideration and action:

“That the Town of Weymouth transfer the sum of \$300,000.00 from Free Cash into a ‘02’ fund account for the purpose of funding costs associated with the refurbishment of former Fire Engine 3 (Pierce Impel Pumper).”

At the time of this submittal the available balance in Free Cash is \$361,668.25.

SUBJ: BALLPARK BUDGET PRICING FOR REFURBISHMENT OF IMPEL PUMPER JOB# 27463

Chief Stark,

Thank you for inquiring about providing a budget request to refurbish your Pierce Impel Pumper. I met last week with Lt. Wall and went over the particulars on what your department is looking for. We are having a Pierce Refurbishment Supervisor coming out in July to Massachusetts and we will have him to a full inspection on your truck to develop a list of items that can be refurbished for you. As for now, I did a general inspection of the truck and contacted the Refurbishment Supervisor by phone to discuss what a good budget number would be for your request for the time being. These are the items discussed to be completed during refurbishment:

1. Engine Overhaul
 - a. Mileage: 102,391
 - b. Engine Hours: 8915
2. Transmission Overhaul
3. Pump Overhaul
4. New Front Bumper
5. New Seats
6. Overhaul/Fix Generator to working order
7. Confirm 12V Pole Lights work
8. Rollup Doors Fixed/Replaced
9. Thorough Cleaning of all compartments
10. Fix/Replace corroded items in undercarriage

A preliminary inspection of the frame was completed and the E-coated Frame looked to be in very good condition. After discussing the above items with the Pierce Refurbishment Representative, we would recommend a budget number in the \$300,000.00 range. This number accounts for not only the work listed above, but also work that I cannot accurately gauge until the Pierce Refurbishment Representative comes out in July and does a complete and thorough examination.
