I submit the following measure to Town Council for its consideration and action:

"That the Town of Weymouth transfer the sum of \$30,000.00 from the Stabilization Fund (8372) to a capital project fund for the purpose of funding costs associated with Conceptional Design Services for Beal's Park.

This need is #99 on the 2022-2026 Capital Improvement Plan

At the time of this submittal the unappropriated balance in the Stabilization Fund is \$6,107,879.55.

This measure requires a legal notice and public hearing.

NOTE: The amount of this stabilization transfer will be replenished with FY21 Free Cash, which is expected to include the unappropriated \$10 million received via the Host Community Agreement with Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC.

Subject: Beal's Park Measure

The purpose of this funding is to develop conceptual design plans including:

Development of passive and active recreational design alternatives for Beal's Park, including parking

Incorporate a skate park into at least 1 of the concept options – Town of Weymouth Recreation Department to provide concept drawings previously received for a skate park

Review existing play equipment and basketball court

Review the condition of the existing iron fence – make recommendations

Review the condition of the existing trees – make recommendations

Incorporation of signage

Identify opportunities for sitting areas

Review lighting options – make recommendations

Incorporate safe pedestrian connections to Bridge Street, Athens Street and Sea Street
