"That the Town of Weymouth appropriate the sum of \$2,819,640.00 from the CPA Unreserved Fund Balance Account (4906-321001), \$125,400.00 from the FY23 CPA Open Space/Recreation Fund Account (49060006 573100), and \$454,960.00 from the FY23 CPA Unreserved Fund Account (49060005 573100) for a total of \$3,400,000.00 for the construction and restoration of Beals Park in North Weymouth."

At a meeting of the Community Preservation Committee held on March 13, 2023, the committee reviewed and discussed the application put forward by Steve Reilly, Director, Department of Parks & Recreation in the amount of \$800,000. The request is for additional funding for the restoration of Beals Park in North Weymouth. The Town is in receipt of 4 bids. All bids came in higher than the engineer's estimate of \$2.6M. The low bid came in at \$3,257,119. This request, in the amount of \$800,000 brings the construction appropriation to \$3.4M and allows for a contingency of \$142,881.

After review and discussion, the following motion was approved unanimously.

Motion to appropriate and fund \$800,000 as follows; \$219,640 from the unreserved fund balance account, \$125,400 from the FY23 account reserved for open space & recreation and \$454,960 from the FY23 unreserved fund balance account.

The Community Preservation Committee appreciates your consideration on this recommendation.

Description:

This request is for \$800,000 for the restoration of Beals Park. The Community Preservation Committee previously recommended \$2.6M for the restoration of Beals Park and \$400,000 for the supply of playground equipment, a gazebo and shade structures.

The \$2.6M request was based on the architect's construction cost estimate. The Town received 4 bids as follows:

\$3,257,119

\$4,530,000

\$5,620,200

\$6,818,000

Activitas reviewed the bids and references and recommended that the Town take the low bidder; JAM Corp. of Worcester, MA in the amount of \$3,257,119.

This request, in the amount of \$800,000, includes a contingency of \$142,881 after awarding the bid.

Describe how this project helps to preserve Weymouth's character:

Beals Park is located in the Sea Street Historic District, as listed on the National Register of Historic Places (2009). One of at least 8 shoe factories in the Sea Street District was owned by Elias S. Beals. His factory was located at 48 Sea Street and Beals lived next door at 40 Sea Street. Additionally, Beals opened a shop at the corner of North Street and Bridge Street where he sold boots and shoes until 1849.

In addition to being a prominent shoemaker, Elias S. Beals (1814-1897) was one of the first three park commissioners in Weymouth.

The new park plan includes interpretive panels. The panels will provide an educational component related to the Sea Street Historic District and the life of Elias S. Beals.
