PETITION FOR POLE AND WIRE LOCATIONS

To the Town Council
Of Weymouth, Massachusetts

Massachusetts Electric Company d/b/a NATIONAL GRID requests permission to locate poles, wires, and fixtures, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, along and across the following public way:

Wharf Street - Install one SO Pole on Wharf Street. Beginning at a point approximately 385 feet Northeast of the centerline of the intersection of Depot Street and continuing approximately 36 feet in a Southeast direction. Install new pole off P8 Wharf Street, Weymouth MA. Pole will be installed between P8 and P7 in the National Grid right of way. The new pole will be labeled P7-50.

Location approximately as shown on plan attached.

Wherefore it prays that after due notice and hearing as provided by law, it be granted a location for and permission to erect and maintain poles and wires, together with such sustaining and protecting fixtures as it may find necessary, said poles to be erected substantially in accordance with the plan filed herewith marked – Wharf Street - Weymouth, Massachusetts.

Also, for permission to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables, and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as each of said petitioners may desire for distributing purposes.

Your petitioner agrees to reserve space for one cross-arm at a suitable point on each of said poles for the fire, police, telephone, and telegraph signal wires belonging to the municipality and used by it exclusively for municipal purposes.

Notice having been given and public hearing held, as provided by law,
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that Massachusetts Electric Company d/b/a NATIONAL GRID and
be and it is hereby granted a location for and permission to erect and maintain poles and wires to
be placed thereon, together with such sustaining and protecting fixtures as said Company may
deem necessary, in the public way or ways hereinafter referred to, as requested in petition of said

Poles shall be of sound timber, and reasonable straight, and shall be set substantially at the
points indicated upon the plan marked – Wharf Street - Weymouth, Massachusetts.

all of said wires and cables shall be placed at a height of not less than twenty (20) feet from the
ground.

Wharf Street - Install one SO Pole on Wharf Street. Beginning at a point approximately 385 feet
Northeast of the centerline of the intersection of Depot Street and continuing approximately 36 feet
in a Southeast direction. Install new pole off P8 Wharf Street, Weymouth MA. Pole will be
installed between P8 and P7 in the National Grid right of way. The new pole will be labeled P7-50.

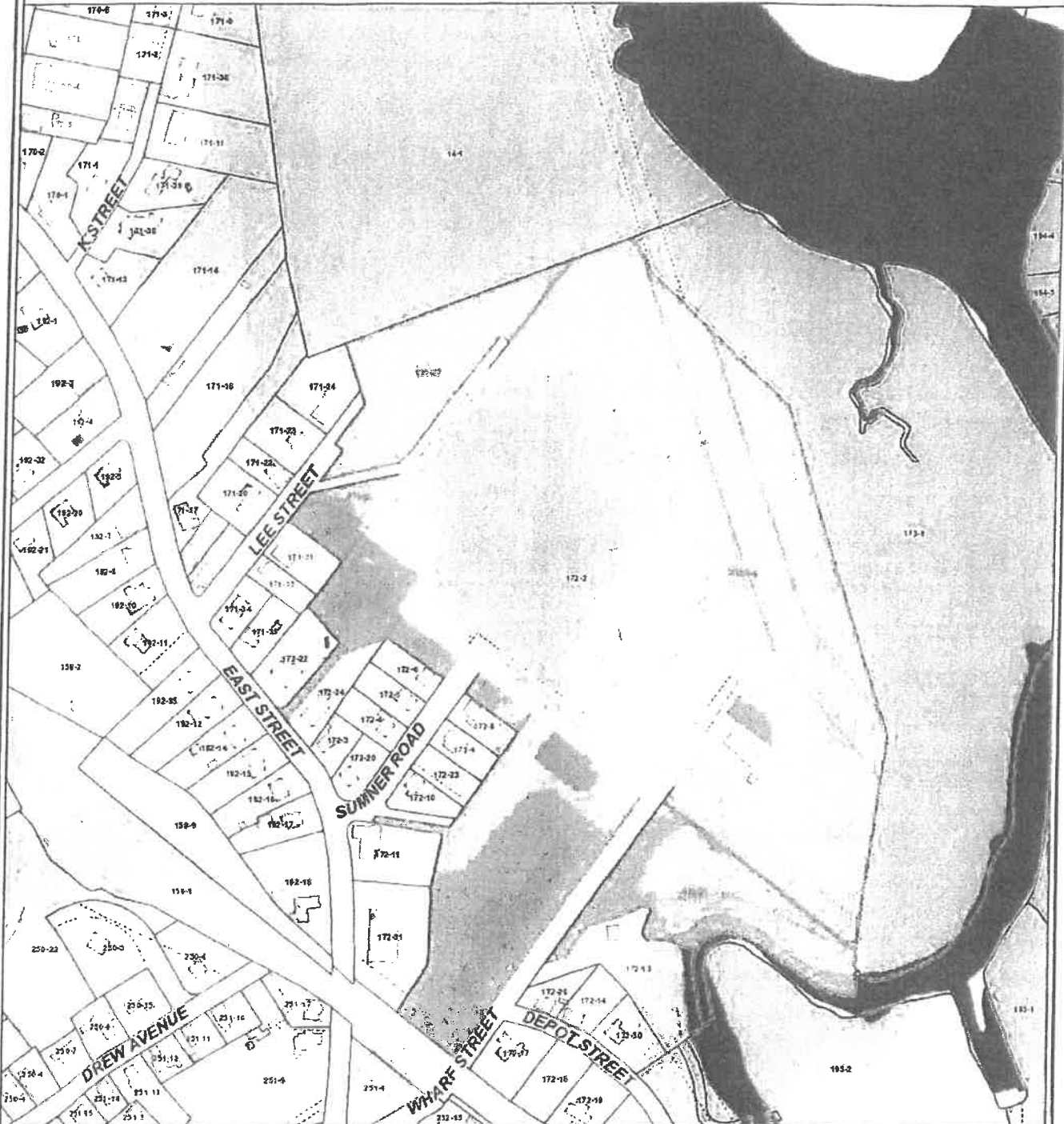
