## 18 054-Department of Asset Management Ordinance Revision

This matter was referred to the Ordinance Committee on April 17, 2018. This action is based upon action already taken. The Town Council voted to Adopt MGL Ch. 37M – and this measure seeks to amend the Ordinance and remove the last clause from measure 18 011.

A motion was made by Councilor Mathews to forward measure 18 054 to the full Town Council with a recommendation for favorable action, pending a favorable public hearing, and was seconded by Councilor Haugh. UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

## 18 055-Ordinance Revision-Director of Asset Management

This matter was referred to the Ordinance Committee on April 17, 2018. Chairman DiFazio noted that the Ordinance was not amended to include a job description for the Director of Asset Management. Councilor Haugh suggested the measure should include the phrases:

"Department of Asset Management" and "Director of Asset Management" capitalized in the measure, sections 3-336 each time they appear.

A motion was made by Councilor Haugh to forward measure 18 055 to the full Town Council with a recommendation for favorable action, as amended, and was seconded by Councilor Heffernan. UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.
