President Mathews called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM. After the Pledge of Allegiance, Town Clerk Franklin Fryer called the roll, with 3 members absent. President Mathews reported that Councilors Conlon, Pap and Whitaker had prior commitments. He thanked those who were able to attend this evening on short notice.

NEW BUSINESS

11 099 Final 2011 Re-Precincting Plan for the Town of Weymouth-Secretary of State's mandated voting deadline-June 15, 2011-measure to be considered under 2-9(b), same night action

President Mathews reported that this matter was originally voted under measure 11 076-Federal Re-districting. It was referred to the Budget/Management Committee on May 23, 2011. The committee met on May 4, 2011 and voted to forward to the full Town Council with a recommendation of favorable action. The Town Council approved the measure on June 6, 2011, adopting the Federal Redistricting Plan to take effect in 2012. This redistricting was a result of the 2010 United States census; however, the Secretary of State has made a minor change to the draft plan. The plan currently before the Council is the final recommendation from the Secretary of State. The only change from the previous map is a water boundary line in Precinct 6. Ms. Deree confirmed the change.

A MOTION was made by Vice President O'Connor to consider measure 11 099 under 2-9(b), same night action and was seconded by Councilor Smart. UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.

A MOTION was made by Vice President O'Connor to approve measure 11 099 and was seconded by Councilor Smart.

At the request of President Mathews, a MOTION was made by Vice President O'Connor to withdraw his motion.

A MOTION was made by Vice President O'Connor to approve measure 11 099; that the Town of Weymouth accept the Final 2011 Re-Precincting Plan for the Town of Weymouth, as presented by the Town Clerk, and consisting of the final map, legal description and block listing based upon the population as determined by the 2010 United States Census, as required by Section 6, Chapter 54 of the General Laws and was seconded by Councilor Smart. UNANIMOUSLY VOTED, 8-3.

At 7:36 PM; there being no further business, a MOTION was made by Vice President O'Connor to adjourn the meeting and was seconded by Councilor Smart. UNANIMOUSLY VOTED.
