

Bradford Torrey Bird Sanctuary



Access: Access: Parking for the Bradford Torrey Bird Sanctuary is located on Main Street (Rt 18). Parking available at the high school during non school hours. Pedestrian access can be found at Arbor Hill, Mediterranean Drive and Tall Oaks Drive.

Trails: 2.5 miles of trails, including a 1 mile loop trail (yellow blazes)

Welcome to the **Bradford Torrey Bird Sanctuary**, 110 acres of conservation land located in the heart of Weymouth, named after ornithologist and outdoor author Bradford Torrey (1843-1912). The Bradford Torrey Bird Sanctuary was acquired by the town through a series of land donations dating back to 1937, when John w. Seabury donated a parcel of land previously owned by Bradford Torrey. Bradford Torrey authored several essays reflecting on his land, including *My Real Estate*. With over 2.5 miles of trails, The Bradford Torrey Bird Sanctuary offers opportunities for passive recreation including hiking, biking, and wildlife viewing.

As is the case with all the town's trails, all dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6ft. Please pick up after your dog and check for ticks.
