**To install and maintain approximately 700 feet more or less of 4 inch, 60#, gas main in Summer St., Weymouth, from existing 2 inch 60# gas main in Homestead Ave., southwesterly to Rucille Ave. Including a 4 inch stub to cross the street to serve Lester Ln. To prepare for the future removal of the regulator in Summer St. at Rucille Ave.**

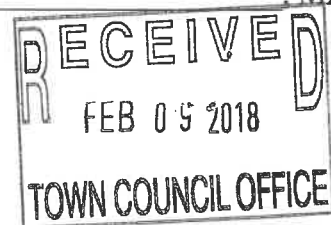
**Town of Weymouth / Town Council:**

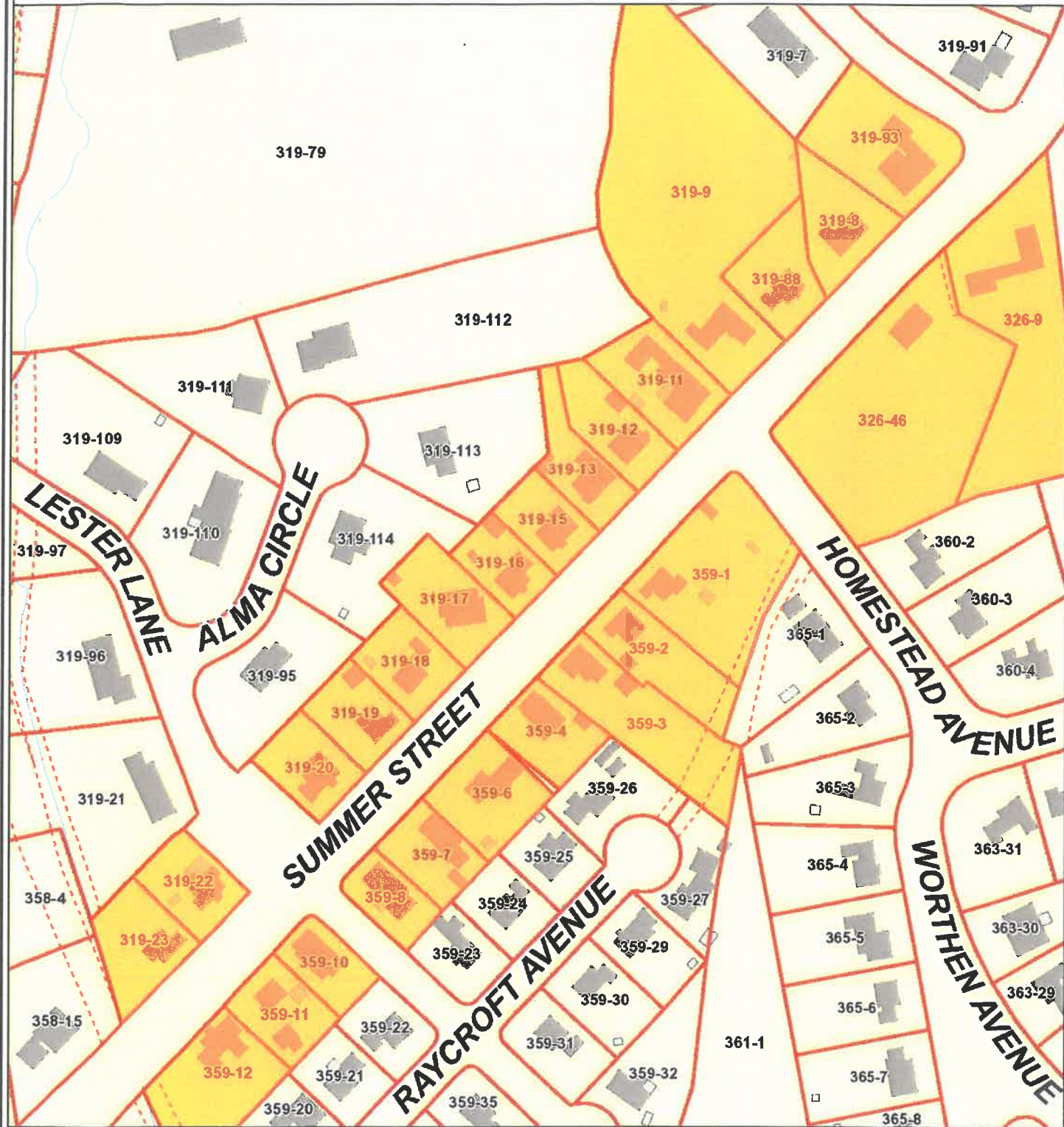
