Notice having been given and public hearing held, as provided by law, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: that MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY and VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC. be and they are hereby granted joint or identical locations for and permission to erect and maintain poles and wires to be placed thereon, together with such sustaining and protecting fixtures as said Companies may deem necessary, in the public way or ways hereinafter referred to, as requested in petition of said Companies dated the 29th day of January, 2018

All construction under this order shall be in accordance with the following conditions:-

Poles shall be of sound timber, and reasonably straight, and shall be set substantially at the points indicated upon the plan marked-

Plan No. 25716959 Dated 1/25/2018 filed with this order.

There may attached to said poles by said MASSACHUSETTS ELECTRIC COMPANY not to exceed twenty wires and by said VERIZON NEW ENGLAND, INC. not to exceed forty wires and four aerial cables, and all of said wires and cables shall be placed at a height of not less than eighteen feet from the ground.
