New Chapman Middle School Wins National Design Award

Mayor Robert Hedlund and Ted Langill, Chief of Staff and Chair of the School Building Committee are pleased to announce HMFH Architects, Inc. was awarded the Grand Prize in Learning by Design's Spring 2023 Educational Facilities Design Awards program for their design of the new Maria Weston Chapman Middle School. A national recognition, the award honors projects that incorporate next generation learning spaces and planning concepts.

Mayor Hedlund appointed Ted Langill to chair the School Building Committee in 2016 to oversee the \$164.2 million project which was completed in collaboration with the Weymouth Public School District, the community, and its partners. The new two-story innovative learning facility located at 1051 Commercial Street opened on-time with millions left in contingency funds, despite the heart of the project happening during the peak of the COVID-19 pandemic.
