Enclosed is a copy of the revised Flood Insurance Study (FIS) materials for Norfolk County, Massachusetts (All Jurisdictions) prepared by the Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). These materials include revised Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) panels, a revised FIRM map Index, and a revised Flood Insurance Study or FIS report. We are providing the enclosed revised materials for administrative purposes only; the flood hazard information for your community was not modified in this revision. To avoid confusion, please replace materials that you currently have on file with the most recent copy.

As you are aware, your community shares the enclosed map index with several other jurisdictions in the county. Future revisions to the enclosed FIRM index will only be issued to you if a FIRM panel on which your community is located is revised. Therefore, this FIRM index will remain valid for your community until such time as a panel on which your community is shown is revised.

It is also important to note that if your community annexes land on adjacent FIRM panels in the future, you must obtain a current copy of the adjacent panel as well as the current FIRM index.
