

Home construction and/or demolition debris is no longer picked up at curbside. Please see the agreement that the Town of Weymouth has in place for residents to use the Braintree Transfer Station.

Resident rate for the Braintree Transfer Station

There has been a rate established for the resident's use of the Braintree Transfer Station from surrounding communities for the disposal of municipal solid waste (MSW). The rate became effective on October 1, 2008 and residents must provide identification indicating community residency. The rate is \$0.10 per pound with no minimum for such customers. Checks or cash are NOT accepted at the transfer station.

Acceptable items are listed below:

Large metal items such as washers, dryers, stoves, water heaters, furniture, household items, microwaves, scrap metal, storm doors, toilets, sinks, wooden doors/decks/fencing/shingles/lumber, etc., gutters, lawn mowers with gas and oil removed, carpeting and bicycles.

Only latex paint in solid form in open containers may be received.

Large items that require additional charges such as refrigerators/freezers and dehumidifiers - \$25.00 (CFC's MUST be removed; charge covers management of appliance).

Unacceptable items are listed below:

No items considered to be "Hazardous Waste" by the Federal Government or the State of Massachusetts are acceptable.

No propane tanks or yard waste.

No paints, other than solid latex paint.

The above list is not all inclusive, but is intended as a guideline for acceptable and unacceptable items considered for disposal at the transfer station.

Individuals who leave items at the facility improperly (dumped at the gate or other location at the site) will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
